1. PEER RECOVERY SPECIALIST (CPRS)

This role provides peer recovery services across community, clinical, and justice settings, while also mentoring PRS interns and entry-level peer staff.

Conduct in-reach services within the Prince William Adult Detention Center



Connect participants to treatment, housing, employment, and recovery resources



Support individuals preparing for successful reentry
Facilitate recovery groups and peer support



Collaborate with justice, healthcare, and community partners



Complete documentation and participate in team meetings



2. LEAD CERTIFIED PEER RECOVERY SPECIALIST

Ideal for experienced CPRSs who enjoy mentoring peers and helping strengthen recovery services across multiple locations.

Mentors junior PRS staff



Supports onboarding and training



Helps reinforce consistent peer practice across sites



Designed as a pathway toward supervisory or coordination roles
